Vocational Education at a Glance:-

Vocational Education programme is a Centrally-sponsored Scheme is implemented in Odisha since 1988-89. As such 231 Government Vocational Higher Secondary School (GVHSS) are functioning in the state in the premises of 231 Government and Non-Government Aided Colleges of the State. It aims at imparting education at the Higher Secondary stage designed to create middle level skilled personnel who can become self employed by starting their own enterprises. Besides self-employment, the vocational pass outs may opt for jobs in government/private sectors or may pursue higher studies. For details log in to www.dveodisha.in

Vocational Course:-

At present **Ispat (Govt. Vocational) Higher secondary School** is functioning in the campus of the Ispat Autonomous College, offering the education in Vocational stream with two trades, one is in Engineering based **EDA (Electrical Domestic Appliances)** and other is in Agriculture based **HORTICULTURE**. The Principal of the Ispat Autonomous College is the In-charge Principal of this institution. The Institution is functioning since 2016 and admission is conducting for 24 seats in EDA trade and 24 seats in Horticulture trade online with +2 admissions by SAMS (Students Academic Management System). Syllabus and Examination :-

A student, who has passed in the High School Certificate Examination from a recognized Board or Council, is eligible to take admission in a vocational trade running in one of the GVHSS in the State. The duration of the course is two years, at the end of which the examination is conducted by the Council of Higher Secondary Education (CHSE), Orissa, which also issues certificates to the pass outs. The examination consists of the four compulsory subjects i.e. English, MIL, Environmental Education & Yoga and Basic Foundation Course (BFC) like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics or Biology. Besides these, there are two theory papers and two practical papers related to the trade subjects. Syllabi for all the trades have been prepared by the CHSE in consultation with subject experts in the light of guidelines issued by Pundit Sunderlal Sharma Central Institute of Vocational Education (PSSCIVE), Bhopal a constituent body of the NCERT, New Delhi. At present teaching is imparted in 20 trades and each GVHSS offers 2 trades out of 20. These trades are approved under the Apprentice Act 1961. The maximum number of students to be admitted for each section in any trade shall be 24.

Admission Procedure: -

Admission for Vocational course is conducted in online basis with +2 admissions by SAMS. From the list of Higher Secondary Schools (HSS) in the online form one have to select the name of HSS as **ISPAT (GOVT. VOCATIONAL) HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL** for the Vocational course. Then from the option for EDA and HORTICULTURE, to choose one course. For any query, contact to the helpdesk at Ispat HSS or mail us in gvicispatrkl@gmail.com

Fee Structure:- Since this admission is for a Government HSS i.e. Ispat GVHSS and it is a Government Sponsored course the admission fees for +2 1st year general students is **Rs 960.00** and Readmission fees for 2nd year students is **Rs 560.00** with a monthly Tuition fees for General students is **Rs 9.00**. No Tuition fees for Girl students and SC and ST students. Total fees for two years are under Rs 2000.00 for a general category student.

Placement:- According to the Apprentice Act 1961 the Vocational pass outs are eligible to join as an Apprentice Trainee with a monthly stipend for one year in different public and Govt./ private Sector. Our Institution is sending the list of pass outs every year according to requirement of Different organisation, basically to SAIL.
